AMENDMENT – FLOOR ELECTIONS

- **8 RSMC Regional Conference Delegates (+2 Alternates)**

Eligibility: To be eligible to run as a Regional Conference Delegate, incumbents must be members-in-good-standing who have attended fifty per cent (50%) of all GMMs in the previous twelve (12) month period. For the election meeting, a member must be in attendance or have submitted, in writing to the Secretary-Treasurer, their intention to stand for election. As part of the Regional Conference delegation one delegate shall be elected from the Edmonton Local affiliates. For this delegate the General Meetings Requirement shall be waived

FLOOR ELECTIONS – NON-EXECUTIVE TABLE OFFICERS

- **Chief Shop Steward – RSMC – West Zone (until April 2022)**

Eligibility: In order to be eligible as a candidate for a Local Officer position, the nominee must have attended, and maintain at least 3 General Membership Meetings in a year; must be a member-in-good-standing and must be nominated by a member in-good-standing at a General Membership Meeting. In addition to the above, in order to be eligible as a candidate for a CSS position, the nominee must be an active Shop Steward, or have taken the Basic Shop Steward course, minimum 3 day.
