Edmonton Executive Elections 2021

Between General Membership Meetings your Local is run by an Executive Committee. The Executive committee positions are elected on a 3-year cycle. All officers of the local are expected to undertake their duties with co-operation, communication, collaboration and solidarity.

Nominations for this year will be accepted for the positions as follows:

- **President (Full time Officer) (Bylaw 6.2)**
The President will preside at all meetings of the Local and the Executive Committee, preserve order, enforce the National Constitution of the C.U.P.W, the By-laws of the Local, and be generally responsible for the affairs of the Local subject to the direction of the Executive Committee and the General Membership.
- **Health and Safety Officer (Full time Officer) (Bylaw 6.5)**
The Health & Safety Officer shall chair and co-ordinate the activities of the Health & Safety Committee, and shall have the right to delegate duties to other members of the committee. The Health & Safety Officer shall work with and assist the Education and Grievance Committees on matters dealing with Health & Safety, W.C.B., and rehabilitation or modified duties.
- **Vice President 2 (EMPP) (Bylaw 6.7)**
The 2nd Vice President shall be the representative for the Edmonton Mail Processing plant (EMPP).
- **Vice President 4 (RSMC) (Bylaw 6.9)**
The 4th Vice President shall be the representative for all RSMC's, and Group 1 members in Affiliate Offices.
- **Vice President 5 (Garage, Maintenance, Registration, Wickets) (Bylaw 6.10)**
The 5th Vice President shall be the representative for the areas of The Garage, Maintenance, Wickets and Registration in Edmonton.
- **Communications Officer (Bylaw 6.12)**
The Communications Officer shall be responsible for the reproduction of the Locals publication, assist will all local email list-serve upkeep, local website, and social media updates. Perform facility visits directed by the President. Keep a complete, correct and impartial record of the minutes of all meetings of the Local and Executive Committee.

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From the Bylaws:

- In order to be eligible as a candidate for the Local Executive Committee, the nominee must have attended at least 50 % of the meetings in the preceding year; and must be nominated by a member-in-good-standing.
- Nominations and acceptances must be submitted to the Election Committee by the close of the office on the fourth Friday in February.
